In the case of this city, a new young couple has just moved there with the hope of doing evangelism and discipleship in this place, and the goal of eventually starting a sound Bible church).

The last week in the month, we have a week-long bike trip to the Pacific Coast planned with a group of about 30 people.

Besides that, I only have one weekly Bible study right now and the San Carlos weekend ministry. Of course, Havilah always keeps me busy!
